	<p>Care of Palliative Care Patients – Imminently dying</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goal – Minimise distress for patients & families • Place of choice to die • Symptom management <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Pain ○ Nausea & Vomiting ○ Nutrition & Hydration ○ Breathing ○ Delirium & Restlessness • General care <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Mouth care ○ Pressure area care ○ Multi-disciplinary approach ○ E.g. Psychological support for families, pastoral care, etc
